Particulars of Repairs and Examination, *On account of a new propeller being fitted. This vessel was put in the South Graving dock here. The propeller was taken off, one of its blades being broken, and the spare propeller fitted. Examined the propeller shaft as far as could be seen and found it in good condition, and down only 8 of an inch. New Main Steam pipe fitted with a stuffing box expansion joint, in lieu of the old one which was patched & had been leaky.*
