The Secretary,

Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 27th Inst. relative to Mess^{rs} Richardson's letter about lining Port-bunker of S.S. "Compton" and asking for my opinion on it.

This vessel having now sailed I would recommend that the owners be notified that great care be taken in turning the bunker this voyage, and that on her return to port the bunker be lined inside as proposed by Mess^{rs} Richardson's with Iron casing in communication with the atmosphere a sufficient distance to keep the coals clear of the Boiler shell girders, and on completion the Society to be notified of it. Under these circumstances, I consider her eligible to have the notification No. C in red in the Society's Register book.


