REPAIRS

This vessel was scraped bright from metal-line upwards with a view to being Continued (Sec^d 54) attended and pointed out what would be necessary so far as the vessel could then be examined. - Recommended the sheer strake amidships and about 3 planks on the Starboard bow and two at quarter to be renewed; the Port-side could not be fully examined, as also the Buttocks but found the sheer strake on the Port-side defective also the Nelson very defective and the Treennails in flat of bottom and recommended the same to be renewed; and a further survey to be made when in a fit state for such. The Owner finding the repairs likely to be extensive declined doing anything stating he would exchange or sell her in her present condition and has since withdrawn the order for Re-classing.
