REPAIRS, &c.

The whole of the metal and wood sheathing stripped off and the remainder of the Galvanized Iron bolts removed from four feet below the planksheers down; and replaced with $\frac{1}{8}$ Yellow metal nut and screw bolts. The windlass unbent and stripped and the chain cables ranced - The bottom cement entirely renewed; the vessel recaulked from keel to planksheers and resheathed with yellow metal on Felt.
