Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration your letter of the 23rd instant, respecting the classification with this Society of the Greenwich Ferry Co's steamers "COUNTESS OF LATHOM" & "COUNTESS OF ZETLAND", and with regard thereto, I am directed to state that in view of the fact that the Special Survey No.1 required by the Rules is now so long overdue in each case, the Committee have decided to defer the question of the continuance of the vessels' characters to the General Committee of the Society, who will meet on Thursday next.

I am instructed to add that in the absence of any definite arrangement as regards the survey in question, the course which will probably be adopted by the Committee will be to expunge the vessels' characters with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules, and under these circumstances, I shall be glad to be favoured with any proposal which you may desire to make for the consideration of the Committee.
