Dear Sir,

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 7th ultimo respecting the case of the steam tug "ALTATA", and with regard thereto, I beg to acquaint you that on the 6th instant I asked the Secretary of the Western Railway Co. of Mexico to give the necessary instructions for the new keel plates to be fitted under the inspection and to the satisfaction of a Surveyor appointed by you and I am now in receipt of a communication from that gentleman, in which he expresses his surprise that the new keel plates have not yet been fitted. He has written to the Manager advising him of the necessity of attending to the matter without further delay.

I shall therefore be very much obliged if you will kindly appoint a Surveyor to attend to the matter, and as the Special Annual Survey of the boilers also becomes due this month, it would be well if advantage were taken of the opportunity afforded by the fitting of the keel plates *to carry out this inspection.* ~~for this survey to be held now.~~
