Dear Sir

On the 22nd inst, I received your letter of the 29th Sept, with sundry printed forms to be filled up on the survey of the coast steamer, "Altata", which will be here to morrow, and proceed up to Guaymas next week, to go on the slipway & be overhauled and surveyed, as directed. She was two months in the estuary here, and was thoroughly overhauled, and is the most useful & punctual steamer on the Coast.

I have written Lloyds that that they have never sent me any Regulations nor printed forms for use, in the event of surveys, and had to write to the Agents in San Francisco for some, which expect down on the 3rd prox. — Our fine season has begun & we are having fine N.W. winds, which have blown the yellow fever bacteria to Hal. we only had half dozen fatal cases — Yours very truly
