I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly let me know what further arrangements have been made for the submission of the vessel to inspection.

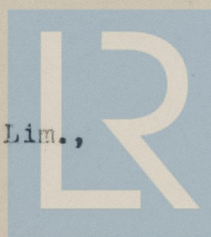
