

I am in receipt of your letter of 6th inst in reference to the overdue surveys on the steamer "Altata" and "Mazatlan" I wrote to Mr Douglas, the Manager in Mexico, in January last in reference to the surveys and I have since heard from him to the effect that the "Mazatlan" has been on the slip at Guaymas and has been thoroughly overhauled.
