

When, however, I found that this was being done, I felt under the circumstances and in view of your letter dated March 30<sup>th</sup>. 88 that (the planning in every respect being of a highly satisfactory character) the only thing remaining to be done to ensure a thoroughly satisfactory job was to see that the butt straps were well & efficiently fitted, and I venture to consider


