satisfactory character) the only thing remaining  
to be done to ensure a thoroughly satisfactory  
job was to see that the butt straps were  
well & efficiently fitted, and I venture to

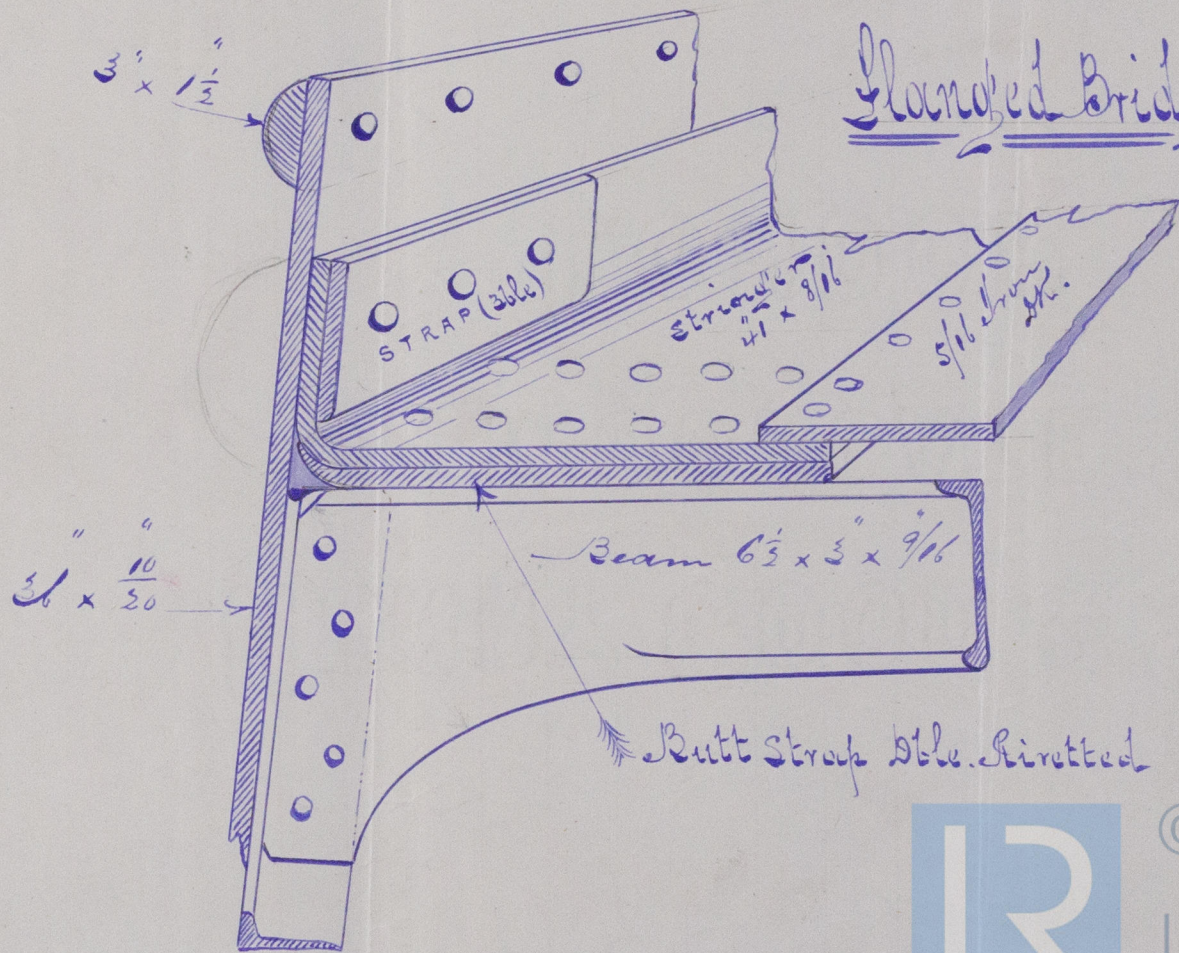

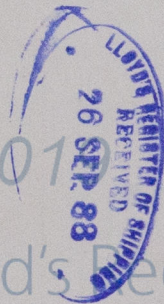
