Gentlemen, I am in receipt of Mr Austin's letter of the 14th inst. submitting for the Committee's approval, the tracing of the ~~Sontey~~ boiler proposed to be made by Messrs Riley Bros. for Messrs. Rapner & Sons' No 256 vessel, and in regard thereto I am directed to acquaint you that the boiler in question will be approved of for the intended working pressure of 90 pounds per square inch, provided the modifications suggested by Mr Austin be carried out; the girders be made 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ inches deep instead of 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches; and the usual conditions of survey and testing be carried out to your entire satisfaction.
