

I beg respectfully to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant with reference to the securities of the boiler of the S/S "OSCAR" and in reply to acquaint you that the boiler of this vessel was in my opinion efficiently stayed to the vessel's side with 3 bars thus:  the stays having a good rake fore and aft and also downward.

The boilers fitted by the N.E.C. have always been stayed in this manner and given no trouble and I may here remark that this is the 9th vessel which has been engaged by this firm and returned to the Middlesbrough district for completion within a
