Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your Steamer "COUNTY DERRY", I am directed to call your attention to the fact that the Special Survey No.1 about which I wrote to you on the 17th January, 1894, and the 17th May, 1895, has not yet been completed, although it became due so long ago as November, 1893, and the year of grace allowed by the Rules within which to complete it expired in November, 1894; neither has any reply been received from you as to what steps you propose to take in the matter.

Under these circumstances the Committee regret they will have no other alternative under the Rules than to deal with the vessel's class, unless they receive a satisfactory assurance from you as to the early completion of the survey, and as the case of the vessel will come up for final consideration at the Committee's next meeting I have to ask you to kindly favour me with a reply by return of post.

In addition to the survey required on the hull as set forth in my letters of the foregoing dates, the whole of the Special Survey requires to be held on the vessel's machinery and boilers.
