Dear Sir,

We beg to inform you that the Cie. de Navigation Paquet, of this port, have placed on board their steamer "ASTER", four lengths of stud link chain cable, 2" diameter, taken from their stock, to replace a similar amount of cable rejected by us for wear. The Rule diameter is 1 15/16".

These lengths of cable have been made by the Forges et Chaineries du Nord, at Saint Amand, and have been tested by the Bureau Veritas. They have also been examined by us, found satisfactory and verified with the Bureau Veritas test certificates Nos 455 and 460, forwarded herewith for reference, and the Owners will be glad if the Committee will accept the chain in this instance and they have asked us to return the certificates to them in due course.
