Dear Sirs,

M. I return herewith the amended plans, forwarded with Mr. Isherwood's letter of the 6th instant, shewing the arrangement of cargo doors proposed for the S.S. "INGELI", and with regard thereto I have to inform you that in view of the fact that the cargo door is partly below the water line when the vessel is loaded, it is considered necessary that one strongback should be fitted across the centre of each door in addition to the clips proposed, and provided the shelf plates be fitted as proposed by Mr. Isherwood, and the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the sketch and to your satisfaction, the same will be approved.

The plans forwarded for reference are also enclosed and the plan of cargo doors previously approved has now been cancelled.

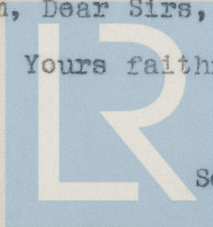
