Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 26th inst, regarding my first entry report to 8046 on the single screw steamer "Aguila", and in reply beg to inform you that:-

- (1) A web frame is fitted on frame to 106.
- (2) The web frames on frames 141 & 144 are 30" deep
- (3) The sheer strake has been doubled at the break as required, and,
- (4) There are five watertight bulkheads fitted, as shown on approved plans.

I regret that these matters were not made clear in my report.

I should add that the ~~the~~ web frame, on frame 106 is 36" wide x .40, and the face angle is 62° x 3½" x 6.
