

(a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to
crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also,
that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the cal-
culations determining the position of the load lines. **Freeboard certificates and
copies have been renewed in accordance with the Regulations of the
