
THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Captain & Agents, attend the "WINDING GULF" Official Number 216767 of Boston, U.S.A. at Norfolk, Va. on the 28th day of August 1945, for the purpose of inspecting (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines. Freeboard certificates and copies have been renewed in accordance with the Regulations of the Commandant, United States Coast Guard, until August 31st, 1946.
