attend the S.S. "WINDING GULF" Official Number 216767

of Boston, Mass. U.S.A. at Baltimore, Maryland

on the 8th day of August, 1944, for the purpose of inspecting

(a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.

In accordance with the Regulations of the Department of Commerce the Renewal Survey is now complete.

A Special General Examination has been held at this time and a record of Examined 8.44 for a period of twelve months has been recommended to the Committee.

A Provisional Freeboard Certificate valid for a period of two months has been issued the vessel.


