I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant stating you have been requested to assign freeboards in accordance with the Convention Regulations to the steamers "CHARLES H. EVEREST", "BIRKENHEAD", "PAULSBORO", "ACME", "EAGLE" & "TIGER", and forwarding copies of the freeboard reports on these ships.

The reports have been examined and are returned herewith with a few minor amendments indicated in pencil.

In the case of the "EAGLE" and "TIGER", it would appear from the sketches that there is an overhang forward and aft of the forward tonnage opening, which is not taken into account in the computation.
