The vessel is to be classed 100 A1 with free-board for full draft of 28'9" (28'8" moulded).

We shall be obliged if you will let us have your approval of the keel and centre girder scantlings at your very earliest convenience, as this is urgently required.

When approving of scantlings generally, we shall be obliged if you will indicate to us if the omission of beam knee at the main deck as well as at the lower and orlop decks would have your approval.
