With reference to your classing letter of the 4th instant in reference to the steamer "Sandown Castle", Sunderland Report No.28188 I beg to state that the spacing of the longitudinal frames is 30" to 36", the size of the upper deck longitudinals is 8" x 3" x .375 bulb angles, the sheer-strake is increased to .84 in thickness at the ends of the break, the size of the face bars on the bridge deck transverse beams and side transverses is 7" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x .54 bulb angles, the shell lugs in the hold are 6"x 6"x .46.

I consider that the record of "Pt.cem" should be made in this case.
