forward in way of p & s, king posts and foremast being dealt with and  
the Special Survey being carried out before the end of December 1948,  
and to the No. 7 hatch cover from forward being renewed upon the vessel's  
return to Baltimore  
being fit to carry dry and perishable cargo.
