With reference to the horizontal sliding watertight doors in Messrs. Cockerills yard No. 675 we beg to inform you that, as now being fitted, the doors will be shewn as closed at the hand gear above the bulkhead deck by an electric red light.

When the door is finally closing it operates a switch which illuminates the lamp and we shall be glad to learn that this meets Section 17 of the Rules.

We may add that the doors are being supplied by Messrs. Stones of Deptford.
