With reference to Messrs.Cockerill's yard No.675 we beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee plans Nos.911883 & 4 shewing some further details of artificial ventilation proposed to be fitted in this vessel.

While the internal arrangements of the trunks do not appear to affect us we shall be glad to learn if stays should be fitted to the ventilator coamings over 910 mm in height on B deck and decks above, and also if means of closing should be provided.

The plans referred to are being forwarded in triplicate under separate cover.
