With reference to plans Nos. 910853, 910863-4 & 5 of Hold Ventilation proposed to be fitted in the case of Messrs. Cockerill's yard No. 675 submitted for approval on the 20th instant we beg to forward for the consideration of the Committee plan D 90020/29 shewing details of an amended arrangement of the ventilation trunks in way of the ~~bottom~~ girders.

The proposal is to try and meet the Owners wishes as they fear the trunks passing under the girder will be soon damaged by cargo.


It will be observed that the trunk is thickened up in way of the girder and merits in our opinion favourable consideration.
