M. I return, under separate cover, the two copies of the plan, forwarded with Mr. Laing's letter of the 22nd instant, shewing the arrangement of a windlass proposed to be made for Chain Cable of 69.5 mm. diameter for Messrs. John Cockerill's Yard No. 675, and with regard thereto I have to state that the only printed requirements of this Society regarding windlasses are given in Section 39, Paragraph 7 of the Rules. The Society's Surveyors are required, however, to test windlasses under working conditions and satisfy themselves that they are capable of handling the anchors and chains in an efficient manner.

The type and details of the windlass itself are matters to be determined between the Owners and Builders.
