We beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee a plan received from Messrs. Le Titan Anversois shewing the arrangement of a windlass proposed to be made for Chain Cable 69.5 mm. dia. presumably this will be for Cockerill's No. 675.

It is submitted the arrangement appears to be such as could be accepted provided that after fitting on board trials be witnessed and found satisfactory.

Should the electric motor be over 100 KW arrangements will be made for it to be built under our survey in accordance with the rules.

The plan referred to is being forwarded in duplicate under separate cover.
