

Welin Maclachlan Gravity Davits intended for Cockerill's No. 675 ship.

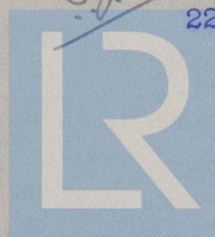
Plan, in triplicate, submitted by the Antwerp Surveyors together with a copy of a letter received from Messrs. Welin Maclachlan, Paris.

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed that provided the davits be constructed as shewn and to their satisfaction, the same will merit approval for the maximum load and outreach indicated on the plan.

The steel to be used in the construction of these davits must be made by the Open Hearth process at works recognised by the Committee, and be tested by the Surveyors in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

The Surveyors should satisfy themselves that the workmanship is sound and should pay special attention to the electric welding of the davits. The Rules for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction must be complied with, and the electrodes used comply with Section 4, para. 1-9 of these Rules.
