M. I return, under separate cover, two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Wray's letter of the 21st instant, shewing the general arrangement of supply and exhaust natural ventilation for Messrs. John Cockerill's Yard No. 675, and with regard thereto I have to state that the heights of the ventilator coamings and the scantlings of the same as shewn and amended on the plans will be approved. At the same time I have to point out, however, that these are limited to the swan-neck ventilators, and no particulars appear to be given of the proposed scantlings of the large swan and cowl ventilators to the holds and tween decks, and these might be embodied on a separate sketch and submitted for approval.

The remaining copy of each of the plans is being retained for reference.
