With reference to your letters of the 9th instant and 31st ultimo regarding the hatch webs and covers of Messrs. Soc. Anon. John Cockerill's Yard No. 675, I have to state that with the disposition of webs as now detailed by you the scantlings of these members as shewn on plan No. 92552 approved on the 6th December 1937 are suitable for cargo of normal density stowed in the trunks.

I think it well to add for your information that the note regarding the density of the cargo in No. 3 trunk was made on the assumption that webs were not to be fitted at "C" or "D" decks, but your letter now states that they are only to be omitted at "D" deck, and on this account this note is not now applicable.
