
Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to your telegram of the 23rd ultimo regarding the anchors and cables for the Steamer "KURLAND", I have to acquaint you that, so far as the classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book is concerned, the anchors and cables will be accepted by the Committee provided they have been tested at a proving machine recognised by the Committee and otherwise are in accordance with the requirements of Table 31.

The Owners, however, will no doubt bear in mind that in accordance with the Chain Cables and Anchors Act, such equipment, in the case of British Registered Vessels, is required to be tested at a proving machine licensed by the Board of Trade.
