I have to confirm the following telegrams that have passed between us relative to the case of the ex-German Steamer "KURLAND", viz:-

Received:- "Anchors and cables Steamer KURLAND made and tested in Germany by Borsig and certificates are here stop please wire whether these can be accepted without retesting".

Sent:- "Steamer KURLAND Merchant Shipping Act requires all anchors and cables for British Ships tested at Proving Establishment recognised by Board of Trade stop in view special circumstances in this case question is being raised officially with Board of Trade stop vessel should not be delayed in meantime".

I should add that instructions will at once be sent to you as soon as a decision on the point is received from the Board of Trade.
