Dear Mr. Thomas,

I think it well to let you know that we hear from the Ministry of Shipping of the sale of the ex-German steamer "KURLAND" to the Robert Dollar Co. The Owner, Mr. Dollar, was in this Office, and has arranged to send to Dr. Montgomerie the plans of the steamer with a view to her being surveyed for classification. You will no doubt hear from Dr. Montgomerie on the subject later on.

The steamer "BONN", which is lying at Leith, has been sold to Messrs. James Mitchell & Sons of Dundee, and I have written to Mr. Mackirdy asking him to take up the question of classification with these Owners. She was surveyed for condition by the Glasgow Surveyors while lying in the River at Grangemouth in October last.

The steamer "COLN" has been sold to the Jura Steamers Trading Co. This is a steamer of which we gave you notice of condition surveyed as desired by the Ministry of Shipping on the 26th June last, but we do not seem to have had anything from you on the subject.

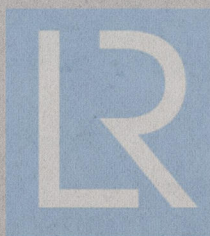
Is this one of the vessels which was in such indifferent condition that the condition survey was suspended? You might let me know how it stands. She is an old steamer built in 1884.
