Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement. (Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

A PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 7.50.

Proposal to postpone the Special Survey for three months approved, see letter dated 27.10.50.

The CARDIFF Surveyors report, the vessel examined afloat and repairs effected to 'tween deck bunkers and other items.

It was noted that cement boxes were fitted at the forward end of No.1 hold (p.s.) and in No.3 hold (p.s.). These appear tight and were not disturbed at this time.

The Surveyors recommend the structure in way be permanently repaired by 1.51.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED for Special Survey.

INSERT IN S.R.L.

Repairs to structure in way of cement boxes in Nos. 1 & 3 holds by 1.51.
