We are informed by Messrs. Bartram & Sons Ltd. that they have received instructions from the Owners, The Atlantic Shipping & Trading Co. Ltd. of the two steamers Yard Nos. 256 & 257, to complete at the earliest possible date. Names have now been assigned to the vessels, and our freeboard verification and first entry reports will be forwarded on Monday first.

No. 256 steamer was launched on the 20th. February, 1924, and No. 257 on the 19th. May, 1924.

We understand that Mr. Bartram will call upon you on Monday morning with reference to the date of build, the fitting of shifting boards and other minor items is being completed, but we do not know if it is intended to dry dock the vessels before sailing?
