


We duly received your letter of 20th May, the contents of which we have submitted to Messrs. Yih & Sons Steamship Co.

We have received a letter from them confirming that this steamer was duly examined by Mr. C. Ritchie, your Surveyor at Hongkong, whilst afloat and in drydock, including drilling and hammer testing of her shell plating, and the examination of her Main Engines, Boilers and Auxiliary Machinery etc.
