I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant and have submitted to the Committee at their meeting today the communication addressed to this Office by Messrs. Yih & Sons Steamship Co. on the 12th instant.

The Committee note that the Owners state the vessel has been fully opened up for Special Survey but that they desire to limit repairs to those necessary for a period of one year's trading.

In view, however, of the fact that a Special Survey became due so long ago as February 1951, the Committee do not feel they can agree to the completion of the inspection being postponed for any further period.

They must, therefore, request the Owners to make the necessary arrangements for the Special Survey to be completed in all respects now if the vessel is to retain her class.
