I have to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of the 22nd ultimo respecting the steamer "CAXAMBU" worded as follows:

On receipt of the above I immediately informed the Owners by letter of the contents and before replying they wished to await the receipt of a letter from the Master of the vessel explaining how it was the survey was not completed as arranged, at an interview with the Secretary yesterday he informed me they had received the expected letter but no mention was made of the survey, so that they cannot say anything until the vessel arrives at Santos where she is bound.

The Secretary further stated that the vessel is proceeding to Santos and will reload there and proceed direct to

New York, so that they will not be able to do anything towards completing the survey this voyage but he will give definite instructions to the Master that the same must be completed on the next arrival at New York.

The vessel is expected to arrive at Santos on the 21st instant, after which I will again see the Owners and cable you if the survey is not carried out here.

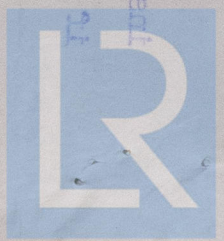
