S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd ultimo respecting the maintenance of the classification of the Motorship "MAIMUNA", and in reply I have to say that, in the special circumstances of this case, the Committee would not insist upon the vessel being taken to Singapore for ordinary docking, damage or Boiler Surveys, or for the Special Survey No. 1, which will become due on the vessel in January 1930. For such surveys it will be sufficient for the Society's purpose, if you will kindly appoint a local competent Surveyor to carry out the same, and I shall be glad to hear in due course, what decision the Owners come to in the matter.
