

Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th June, referring to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the motor vessel "MAIMUNA", and note the intimation which you have received from the Acting Chief Secretary, Sarawak, to the effect that it is not desired to maintain the class of the vessel in the Register Book. The Committee have had the matter before them to-day, and in the circumstances they have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I may add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is accordingly cancelled and should be returned to this Office.

I shall be much obliged if you will be so good as to advise the Chief Secretary, Sarawak, accordingly and endeavour to arrange for the freeboard certificate to be
