Plans for this vessel were approved in November 1921 when the Builders were informed that provided certain conditions and ~~the~~ arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the plan, and the equipment be in accordance with the letter b. Table 31 of the Rules, the vessel would be favourably recommended to be classed for a period of 11 years.

The vessel has not been built under survey and since ~~it~~ launched in May 1923 has been laid up at the Builders' Yard.

At the request of the Builders a survey has been held with a view to classification.

The London Surveyors now forward a report giving particulars of scantlings. The vessel has been examined on blocks and found generally in good condition.

The equipment is in accordance with the Rule requirements.

The workmanship is good.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed
