I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo in further reference to the case of the Wood Motorship "DUVALLA" and in reply to acquaint you that as intimated in my letter of the 19th ultimo in accordance with the Committee's instructions the class of the vessel has been omitted from the reprint of the Register Book for issue in July next.

The Committee note the Owners do not desire the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, but the Committee regret that in view of the importance which they attach to the Half Time Survey they have no alternative but to adhere to their previous decision, namely:- that to entitle the vessel to have her class re-instated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the Half Time Survey on the hull and machinery to be carried out at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed and for a favourable report to be received.
