Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of 19th inst., relating to the M.V. "Duvalla" we have now heard from the owners, The United States Trading Co., Akron, Ohio, U.S.A. on the subject of the survey of this vessel.

We quote the following which will probably be of interest to you,

"We also wish to confirm our cable of today in which we requested you to advise their London Office that the survey as requested for June has been authorized to our Liberia Office.

We have previously explained to Lloyd's that this vessel was not being used in any manner whatsoever but was held at anchor in Marshall Bay, which, as you are aware, is almost entirely cut off from the sea.

We of course do not wish to have this vessel dropped from the Register nor do we wish to have the insurance policy cancelled on same. We trust that you will advise them along these lines, pending receipt of the survey to be made by Lloyd's Agents at Monrovia who will go to Marshall for this purpose."

and trust that same will enable you to reinstate the vessel in the Register Book.
