I think it well to inform you however that the class of this vessel has been omitted from the reprint of the Society's Register Book, and that The United States Trading Co. of Akron, Ohio were informed accordingly in a letter which was sent to them from this Office on the 24th ultimo.

To entitle the vessel to have her class re-instated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the Half Time Survey on the hull and machinery to be carried out at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed and for a favourable report to be received. X
