

Wood Twin Screw Motor Vessel "DUVALLA", 167 tons gross, built
in 1923 - 5 mo.

The Screw Shaft Survey of this vessel became due
in 6,28, and the Half Time Survey in 12,29.

In December last the Committee agreed to the vessel
remaining as classed, provided she were generally examined
and favourably reported upon. As no general examination had
been held, the Committee decided to omit her class from the
reprint of the Register Book.

A letter now now been received from the Owners'
London Office stating that their Manager in Liberia has been
cabled instructions regarding the survey of this vessel in
June next, and desiring to be informed if it will be necessary
for the Society to inform its nearest Surveyor.

It is submitted the Writers be informed that the
class of this vessel has been omitted from the reprint of the
Society's Register Book, in accordance with the Secretary's
letter of the 24th ultimo addressed to their Head Office at
Akron, Ohio, and that to entitle her class to be reinstated
in the Register Book, the Half Time Survey on the hull and
machinery will require to be carried out at a port where the
Society has a Surveyor stationed, and ~~for~~ a favourable report
~~to be~~ received.

A list of ports where the Society's Surveyors are
stationed should be sent to them, and they should be asked to
inform this Office when and at what port this survey will be
held.
