I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo, with its enclosure, respecting the motorship "DUVALLA", and in reply I have to say that in the special circumstances of this case, and in order to meet the convenience of the Owners, the Committee will be agreeable to the Screw Shaft survey and Half Time Survey being postponed until the end of June next, subject to the vessel's hull and machinery being generally examined and favourably reported upon by a competent and independent Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agents at Marshall Junk.
