Survey of the Screw Shaft "DUVALLA".

We enclose herewith a copy of the report from the Cavalla River Co., Agent at Marshall Junk in which he states that it is impossible to survey the Screw Shaft without the vessel going into Dry Dock.

The C.R.C. Agent Monrovia has also inspect the boat and confirms the opinion of the Agent at Marshall Junk. There is no dry dock nearer than Lages, and the rise and fall of the tide at Junk is only two feet (2') which renders it impossible to survey the vessel at that Port. We shall be pleased to hear from you what in your opinion would be the best to do in the circumstance.
