I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th instant respecting the plan showing scantlings in oil tanks in way of sheer approved for your Yard Nos. 1561 & 1562 and with regard thereto I have to inform you that your proposal to plate the longitudinal bulkheads in Nos. 8,9 & 10 tanks vertically in one length from the keel to the upper deck, the thicknesses of the plating being :- No.8 tank - .44", No.9 tank - .45" and No.10 tank - .46", will be approved.
